POLICY STATEMENT FOR HOMEWORK

The level of homework taken on by the child increases as they go through the school.

Children may be required to do homework in the following circumstances :-

- 1) If requested by the parent/guardian, eg. in cases of long term absence, and this would be in conjunction with the Class Teacher.
- 2) They may be asked to complete work that they failed to finish in school.
- 3) Reading books are sent home for the child to read and enjoy with parent/guardian daily.
- 4) Spellings are sent out weekly and learnt at home in Y1/Y2. A spelling test is carried out in school.
- 5) Y1 children have topic related homework as deemed necessary by the class teacher.
- 6) Y2 children receive homework related to the work being done in class weekly. This is usually maths, literacy or topic work.
- 7) On line homework in maths or literacy may sometimes be set.

There is no compulsion for the child to do work at home, but homework is included in our Home/School Agreement and we hope that parents/guardians will see its value and help the child to complete it.
